



Early Mental Health Screening A free resource

Who is eligible?

- St. Louis County residents
- Ages 3 months - 18 months (with developmental focus)
- Ages 1 1/2 - 19 years
- Screening is free of charge



Why screen?

1. To identify concerns early, so they don't multiply and grow more serious.
2. To gain valuable insights helpful for future decisions.

Obtaining a screening is **easy**, and **simple**.

Screening makes things **better**,
for **everybody**: parents, caregivers *and* children.

And it's **free**.

What does screening consist of?

- Interviews with the child and primary caregiver(s)
- Input from family/caregiver(s)/teachers
- Child-centered observations
- Includes developmental screening.

How to get started:

1. Call our screening intake coordinator, Michelle Grodeon at (314) 533-2229 ext 223.
2. Complete and return a one-page referral form and 3 background questions.
3. Schedule the screening appointment. It will take place with our licensed psychologist at the Keystone office (4330 Lindell Boulevard, St. Louis, MO 63108). The appointment block should be 4 hours to allow for a complete screening. Please note: dropping the child off at OLH Keystone is not permitted, the adult must come, too. No child care for sibs is available.

You can expect the best of care at Our Little Haven:

- Mental health screening is conducted by a qualified licensed psychologist;
- You will receive a timely appointment once we have received back the referral forms.
- and a written screening report that contains easy-to-understand recommendations for “next steps” to address identified concerns (and whether concerns are mental health, behavioral health and/or developmental concerns);
- And, you can expect the satisfaction of knowing that you have accessed the best possible start to care, for the benefit of the child and family!
