



Strategic Plan Report

Our continuous work on our Strategic Plan allows us to continue to get better. For 23 years, Our Little Haven, through the generous support of the community, has been offering a safe, secure and healing environment for children and families impacted by abuse, neglect, mental or behavioral health needs. We know how to make the hurting stop, the healing begin, and the love last. Guided by our belief in a loving God, we're always working to improve our practice of effective child and family early intervention services. So, we ask ourselves: *How can we get better at what we do?*

Through months of facilitated planning, our staff contemplated, "With early intervention as our constant, how can we make a good thing even better?"

Together we identified four focus areas:

- Further strengthen program effectiveness
- Improve internal operations and management effectiveness
- Develop organizational capacity and capability
- Enhance community awareness of Our Little Haven's impact.

The conversations, discussions and decisions on these 4 focus areas are facilitated through a Performance Quality Improvement process involving the Strategic Leadership Team which is commissioned by our leadership through the OLH Board of Trustees. The



process welcomes all staff to help strengthen the success and identify opportunities where we can get better at what we do. There has been quite a bit of activity – listening, focusing, learning, resolving and creating – all designed to help OLH get better at what we do best - caring for kids and families that need some nurturing, loving care.

The process has included, for example, opportunities to creatively refine, renew and realign what we do and how we do it:

- Re-affirming the Mission Statement
- Establishing an "invitational" approach to service
- Identifying measurable outcomes and responses to results
- Improving cross-program referrals
- Increasing staff capacity to better serve the kids and families

Board of Trustees Update



Professor Adrienne D. Davis is Vice Provost and William M. Van Cleve Pr

Haven's Board of Trustees.

We are proud to announce that Prof. Adrienne Davis has joined Our Little

Provost and William M. Van Cleve Professor of Law at Washington University in St. Louis. As Vice Provost she focuses on faculty diversity and development, consulting and collaborating with Washington University's seven schools on their goals for diversity and leadership development and also managing a suite of programs from the Office of the Provost. She chairs the University's Diversity Commission, which is charged with designing a university-wide plan for

diversity. She also works closely with other stakeholders at the University, including Public Affairs, Facilities, Student Affairs, Alumni & Development, and Human Resources, on a range of institutional initiatives and programs.

As a legal scholar, Davis is renowned for her scholarship and teaching on gender and race relations; theories of justice and reparations; feminist and critical race theory; and law and popular culture. She has written extensively on the gendered and private law dimensions of American slavery, the legal regulation of intimacy, and how culture and law converge to distribute justice. A Distinguished Lecturer for the Organization of American Historians, Professor Davis directed the Black Sexual Economies Project at the law school's Center for the Interdisciplinary Study of Work and Social Capital from 2009-2013. She also founded and is co-director of the Law, Identity & Culture Initiative. Professor Davis is the past recipient of a Bellagio Fellowship from the Rockefeller Foundation and two research grants from the Ford Foundation on such topics as black women and labor, and women, slavery, sexuality, and religion. Professor Davis also is actively involved in several civic institutions: she is a member of the Links, Inc., St. Louis Chapter, and serves on the Board of Trustees of Opera Theatre St. Louis, Laumeier Sculpture Park, Our Little Haven, december literary magazine, and is currently in her third term as President of the Board of Trustees at the St. Louis Art Museum.


Trivia Night Success
