ALWAYS IN YOUR HEART FINDS A PLACE AT OUR LITTLE HAVEN

Holding baby Callahan in her arms, Ginny Toman often remembers her late Father, John. She wonders what kind of grandfather her dad would be, if he would be called Grandpa or something different, and how much he would spoil his granddaughter.

In early 2019, Ginny and her family lost John to a neurological disease. Her family's loss was shared by all of us at Our Little Haven. John Seiler was a long time board member and friend of the organization. John shared his passions and his time with Our Little Haven, always bringing his humor and wit to events and gatherings.

For Ginny and her family, John's memory lives on. Losing a loved one is always difficult. To help understand loss, the emotional journey she has taken, and offer support for others, she put her thoughts to paper. *Always In Your Heart* is a cleverly written and beautifully illustrated book for young children and adults coping with the loss of a family member. Her hopes are that her daughter will learn who her grandfather was and how special he was to those around him.

With the help of illustrator, Jesslyn Murphy, and Ginny's husband, Scott, they self-published *Always In Your Heart* last year. To commemorate their book release, they dedicated a few copies to the Our Little Academy's Discovery Center Library at Our Little Haven.

John's legacy lives on at Our Little Haven, each year the Our Little Haven Golf Tournament is played in his name and directly supports the John R. Seiler Memorial Scholarship. This Scholarship provides tuition assistance to families who attend Our Little Academy Day Treatment. Scott and Ginny Toman also share their time as members of the Haven Club Young Professionals Group at Our Little Haven.

"LOOK FOR THE HELPERS"



In the early hours on Thursday February 18, 2021, Our Little Academy Day Treatment Preschool was filling with water. Freezing temperatures caused our fire suppression system to burst, gushing water into the halls at an astonishing rate.

Len Kissel was awoken by the St. Louis Police Department letting him know that water was gushing out the door cracks and streaming down Lindell Blvd. Len arrived at Our Little Haven's Program Building greeted by a sheet of ice in the back parking lot, the St. Louis Police Department, the St. Louis Fire Department, and a Fox 2 News crew.

With the help of two firefighters, Len opened the door to find almost two feet of water. Toys, chairs, books, and copy paper

came floating out of Our Little Academy and onto our parking lot.

"It was quite surreal, Our Little Academy was scheduled to welcome children back after a long weekend and two snow days, now their building was engulfed in 22 inches of water" -Len Kissel

The Our Little Academy Team has faced the past year with courage and grace; asking the families and children they serve to be ever flexible as we navigate the pandemic together. Now they ask again for patience while we face this added challenge.

Fox 2 News featured the story later that evening. The pictures shown were bleak; broken pipes, water-stained walls, soggy carpet, and ruined toys. But what shined bright, were the faces, the spirit, and our renewed commitment to the mission. When times get rough, we turn to our heroes, those whose voices give us comfort. For Our Little Haven, it was the words of Mister Rogers.

"When I was a boy, and I would see scary things on the news, my mother would say to me, 'Look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping."

For the disaster that struck Our Little Academy, we look and we see you. We see the 3rd grade class that gathered books. We see the local company that helped us rebuild the kitchen. We see the quick action of the demolition crew. We see the outpouring of support from our community as we surveyed the damage and started to rebuild.
