#### MISSION STATEMENT

Our Little Haven is relentlessly committed to providing early intervention services for children & families. Our community of professional caregivers creates a safe, secure and healing environment for those impacted by abuse, neglect and mental or behavioral health needs. We make the hurting stop, the healing begin and the love last, one family at a time.

#### Services Provided

Our Little Haven provides professional care to enable each child and family's best possible functioning. Early intervention care promotes stable outcomes for young children affected by serious challenges, including early mental and behavioral health needs, abuse or neglect. Care is provided in multiple service settings at our centrally located campus in St. Louis, and through our satellite offices in Jefferson County and Franklin County. Many of our clients have traditionally had limited access to mental health care.

#### Specialized care includes:

- Keystone Mental Health Services for children and families provides comprehensive psychological evaluations, assessments, psychotherapy and psychiatry by Licensed Psychologists, LCSW's, and a Psychiatrist; (with or without Community & professional training, education, and consultation)
- Our Little Academy Day Treatment: Full day treatment for children ages 3-5 who have a variety of mental health issues truama, aggresive behaviors, social challenges, etc. Our team works to address their individual therapeutic needs and help them gain skills to be successful in kindgergarten
- Taylor Family Care Center: Comprehensive case management, including Medical Case Management, for children in the foster care system

#### SERVICE TOTALS:

#### Keystone Mental Health Services

#### • 198 clients served

83% of clients experienced fewer emotional and/or behavioral symptoms after 12 sessions of psychotherapy, as evidenced by a score reduction of at least 1 point on an identified scale, completed at intake and quarterly during treatment.

97% of clients and/or their guardians reported having increased knowledge of presenting concern(s) and/or diagnoses, after completion of a psychological evaluation or assessment.

#### Our Little Academy Day Treatment

#### • 11 children served

90% of children served showed reduced symptoms and improved functioning, indicated by the completion of their treatment goals

90% of children served are stable in their next educational placement, usually kindergarten.

### Foster Care Case Management

#### • 121 children served;

100% in Jefferson County were enrolled in Medical Case Management, 60-70% in St. Louis City and St. Louis County were enrolled in Medical Case Management

Achieves 32% permanency exceeding contract benchmarks.


Children have their medical records brought up-to-date; immunizations/care coordination increased.


