

Our Services, Our Impact

Early intervention changes everything, here's how it's making a difference every day

Together, our three core programs form the foundation of our work and demonstrate the life-changing impact of comprehensive care and support during the critical formative years.

Keystone Mental Health Services



The start of a new school year can bring both excitement and anxiety. For some children, it means

reconnecting with friends and learning new skills; for others, it magnifies challenges with for example, attention, social skills, or emotional regulation. At Keystone Mental Health Services, our clinicians provide a safe space for children and their families to manage these challenges through appropriate therapies, such as play therapy and family therapy, or psychological evaluations and psychiatric support. With this care, children learn to manage anxiety, strengthen resilience and build confidence in the classroom and at home. The impact reaches beyond the child families gain healthier ways to support their children, and teachers are better equipped to meet student needs. Back-to-school season reminds us of the vital role early intervention plays in helping children navigate change and thrive.

Recently we had a client who struggled with debilitating separation anxiety.

Staff would have to greet our young client in the parking lot and coax him into the building. He would cling to his parent and begin screaming, crying, and hitting the second he saw our front door. It would take hours for him to recover and agree to participate in the program - keeping him from engaging in the services he badly needed. After collaboration with the family, we created a plan. Together we created a specific morning routine for our client. The staff crafted a custom social story to help our client decrease stress and better understand his morning routine. The staff created a morning routine chart the client could review in the car on the way to treatment. There were successes and setbacks, but within a few weeks our client was arriving with smiles every morning. He could give a hug, say goodbye, and walk himself to his classroom. He felt proud and safe. Sometimes walking through the door is a success worth celebrating.

Community Family Services (CFS)



When a young child entered foster care with no known relatives, CFS's Diligent Ongoing

Relative Search (DORS) team immediately began the process of uncovering family connections. Within days, they identified more than 20 potential relatives and reached out to each one. After careful screening and conversations, a maternal aunt came forward, eager to provide a safe and loving home. Our DORS team guided her through background checks, paperwork, and preparation so she could be ready to care for her niece. Instead of remaining in foster care, the child was able to reunite with family and begin healing surrounded by familiar love. This outcome reflects the heart of CFS, restoring family connections, guiding permanency, and creating stability for children in uncertain times.



Nurse Shari Sullivan, RN, BSN, our Coordinator of Medical Services, works

to ensure children in foster care receive the medical, dental, and developmental care they need. She is often the steady guide for families navigating an overwhelming system, closing the gaps in care that foster children so frequently face. She approaches every child and family with dignity, respect, and a commitment to making sure no one feels alone in the process.
