Everything was in place; volunteers were ready, the first staff members were working hard, and a few lingering construction workers finishing up. There was nothing left to do but wait – wait until 3:00 pm, when the doorbell rang for the first time. *DING DONG* "What do we do now?" whispered a voice. "Answer the door" replied Kathleen Hummel, "And let the healing begin".

receive the love, compassion, and care that Our Little Haven has provided to over 18,849 children and families during the past twenty-five years. That day, Kathleen and Scott Hummel, along with staff, volunteers, friends, and a few curious construction workers, welcomed "Sean". He was given a bottle, his diaper changed, and laid down for his nap. Everyone stood by the door and watched "Baby Sean" sleep. It was calm, quiet, and peaceful. *DING DONG!* Another child had arrived and Our Little Haven's adventure was just getting started.




Cookies, Kids, and Community
