Foster Care Case Management offers a broad range of services and support to help children and families.

Foster Case Management Services

- Ensure safety and stability for children in contact with the foster care system
- Serve children ages birth through 21
- Connect children to medical, mental health, and educational services
- Link families to community resources to assist in reunifying the family
- Provide family finding efforts so children can remain connected to their family
- Coordinate services for older youth to support a plan of independence
- Strive to connect children to lifelong, permanent homes

Medical Case Management

This program is unique to the St. Louis region. All children served by Taylor Family Foster Care Center receive medical case management services.

- Request & review medical records, & summarize/ interpret for the social work team
- Schedule home visits with clients to assess health status & potential medical, developmental, dental or mental health needs
- Create a care plan for clients while in care & keep the Case Manager informed about the needs of the client
- Provide education for foster parents and biological parents as needed regarding medical, developmental, and mental health needs of clients
- Collaborate with community referral partners and resources to ensure continuity of care for the child
- Attends medical specialist appointments as needed

Saint Louis Partners

Through a contract with the Missouri Department of Social Services, Children's Division, Our Little Haven partners with three other social service agencies to make up the consortium known as Saint Louis Partners. This group has come together to promote the welfare of the children and families through case management, foster care, and adoption. Together, Saint Louis Partners has the power to help more children and families in the community.

Becoming a Foster Parent:

Our Little Haven works together with Saint Louis Partners to recruit, train, and license foster homes for children in foster care. Foster families are always needed for sibling groups, older children, children of minority heritage, and children with special needs.
